The buildings are heated by a

**biomass boiler.**



The wood pellets are sourced in northern Scotland, making our heating **Zero Carbon.**

We plan to monitor and further reduce our **carbon emissions.**

We provide **recycling facilities** for visitors (paper, food, plastic, cans and glass).

We have **reduced single use plastic** use in the Centre café and office.



We don't use any pesticides or herbicides in the gardens. We let some areas grow long to help insects and have a Bug Hotel!
